Collection Information

Please ensure that your containers are put out **at the edge of your property by 7am** on the day of collection. Please take them in as soon as possible after collection.

Please report any **missed bin collections by 5pm** the following working day. Unfortunately we are unable to return for missed collections reported later than this.

Please ensure that your rubbish is contained within the rubbish bin. Extra **rubbish** will not be collected.

Recycling - clean dry and loose

Please help us with our recycling by giving your plastics, cans, foil, glass bottles and jars a quick rinse before placing them loose in your recycling container.

Please remember to remove plastic film from around magazines/junk mail and liners from cereal boxes.



However, extra **recycling** can be placed out in a suitable box or carrier bag (no black sacks) next to your recycling bin and will be collected.

If the collection crews are **unable to gain access** due to road works, parked cars or adverse weather, they will try to return as soon as possible.

Please leave your containers out until they are emptied. During periods of **extreme** weather, please see your local website for updates on your collections.

Flats/properties with communal bins. Please continue to use your bins as labelled.

- ✓ Glass jars
- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Shredded paper (*in clear bags*)
- ✓ Food tins
- ✓ Drink cans
- ✓ Aluminium foil
- ✓ Aerosol cans (*empty*)
- ✓ Plastic bottles (*squash and put lids back on*)
- ✓ Plastic pots, tubs and trays
- ✓ Plastic bags and film
- ✓ Blister packs



No thanks

- ✗ Pyrex/ovenproof glassware
- ✗ Drinking glasses and crockery
- ✗ Window panes
- ✗ Mirrors
- ✗ Light bulbs
- ✗ Black plastic bags
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Garden waste
- ✗ Food/drinks cartons
- ✗ Polystyrene/bubble wrap
- ✗ Hard plastics e.g. toys and plant pots
- ✗ Foil-lined plastic pouches and bags e.g. crisp packets
- ✗ Textiles
- ✗ Refuse

Batteries and Small Electricals

(New Service)

If you have small household batteries (not car batteries) or small electrical items (e.g. toaster) for recycling, please place them in separate carrier bags on top of either your refuse bin or recycling bin for collection.

These can be recycled at your local Household Waste Recycling Site and at some Neighbourhood Recycling Points. Please visit our website for recycling facilities in your area.
