Grass cuttings  
Shrub cuttings  
Plant cuttings  
Flower cuttings  
Weeds  
Roots  
Leaves  
Branches (up to 10cm/4in diameter only)

#### ✗ No thanks

Cardboard  
Paper  
Food waste  
Cat litter and dog waste  
Japanese Knotweed  
Soil  
Rubble  
Plastics e.g. plant pots  
Glass

### **Avoiding heavy garden waste containers**

Please can we ask that consideration is taken to not overfill containers. Wet material especially can make these containers very heavy and unsafe for yourself or the collector to move. It also increases the risk of the container becoming damaged and/or being identified as unsafe to empty and tagged. We would recommend that container(s) are always presented on collection day even if they are only partially full rather than awaiting the next collection when the container is full and much heavier.
